## **Events**

If you have agreed to be contacted about future events, we will hold your personal data for as long as you subscribe to our mailing list.

## **Mailing list**

We are using information about you because you have given us your consent (if you are external to the University of Edinburgh) or where the legal basis of legitimate interest exists (University of Edinburgh) to include you on our mailing list(s) for the purpose of keeping you updated on our news, research activities and events for promoting knowledge exchange and creating future collaboration opportunities; and to ensure each individual receives relevant information.

To do so, we are using Microsoft Outlook, Sympa and Dotmailer as our mailing systems to send you our newsletter and event invitations. The information you provide will be used by the University to:

- Provide you with information on any knowledge exchange events and workshops you and your colleagues can join
